

# Mrs. Fannie Hill

## Last Rites Today

Funeral Rites were at 10 a.m. Friday in the Goodwin Smith Funeral Chapel for Mrs. Fannie Hill, 93, who died Wednesday in a Cherokee nursing home following an extended illness.

Burial was in the Enid Cemetery. Rev. M. Carl Cartwright and Mrs. Hill's nephew, Rev. Don Waters officiated the services.

Mrs. Hill was born Nov. 2, 1876 at Newport, Ky. She moved to Antton, Kan. with her parents while still a young girl and in 1889 to Knipshier where her father settled on a claim.

In 1897 the family moved to a farm southeast of Enid where she lived until her marriage to S. W. Hill. They moved to Cherokee in 1908, where Hill was engaged in the real estate business and as an abstractor.

He preceded her in death in 1937, and she was also preceded in death by a daughter and a step-son.

She is survived by a step-son, J. Wilford Hill of Cherokee; a daughter, Mrs. Martha McCartney; several nieces and nephews, including Mrs. D. S. Waters of Enid.

She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Cherokee; Order of Eastern Star of Cherokee; the Woman's Society of Christian Service and the Cherokee Study Club.
