

# THE JACOB CORDREY FAMILY OF ROSS COUNTY

In establishing family relationships where definitive proof is not available the following General Notes are supportive of assumptions:

1. The 1820 through 1840 censuses were used as a basis to match individuals to the base family.
2. Wagon making is the family business.
3. There are no other Cordrey families in this area during this time period.

Jacob and Betsey Cordrey owned no real estate therefore there is no land or deed records, they had no will, and there was no probate. This family left few records of burial or tombstones.

Due to extensive use of the name Jacob and Noble by Cordrey families from Delaware, it is presumptive that this Jacob is related to these people. There are several family trees available that make this connection but none provide definitive source information of a relationship and contain some obvious errors.

Elizabeth Marten could be the daughter of Benjamin Marten who appears on the 1809 and 1810 tax lists, but there is no record that proves the tie.

CHAUNCEY TAYLOR MAY (M-1641), oldest child of James and Eliza Taylor May, was born August 31, 1846, at Kingston, Ohio. He received his education at Mt. Pleasant Academy, Kingston, and later spent a year or two at Ohio Wesleyan University, Delaware. He married Nancy (Nannie) Cordrey on May 12, 1880.
