

The funeral for Forest S. "Pud" Manning, 81, was at 10 a.m. Monday in the Ringwood Wesleyan Church with the Rev. Al Wagner officiating. Burial followed in the Glenwood Cemetery under the direction of Henninger-Allen Funeral Home.
