John T. Horner

John Truman Horner, 52 years old, of 303 N. Division St., died Wednesday night in St. Joseph's Mercy hospital after a brief illness.

He was born July 29, 1888, in Anthony, Kan. and was married to Susan M. McIntire of Oklahoma, Nov. 14, 1919. He had lived in Ann Arbor since 1934, coming here from Detroit. He was a member of various Masonic bodies in Oklahoma. Since 1928, he had been associated with the research department of the Milk Producers Association of Michigan.
